Côtes du Rhône Rosé 2022

WS Review: A bright, pink-hued rosé, this isn't shy with the bold, weighty red berry and watermelon flavors. Revealing ripe strawberry on a palate framed by crushed flint, this is slightly sturdier than many Provence versions. Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah. Drink now. 40,000 cases made, 10,000 cases imported. From France.—*K.B.*
